

# INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The user's personal data is used by the "Camillian Disaster Service International - CADIS" Foundation, which is the data controller, in accordance with the principles of personal data protection established by the GDPR 2016/679 Regulation and national legislation in force.

## METHODS AND PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING

1. We inform you that the data will be processed with the support of the following means:

- Informatica

with the following purposes:

- Marketing (market analysis and surveys)
- Websites

In particular, for the purposes specified below the user's data will be processed ONLY on specific acceptance of consent:

## LEGAL BASIS

2. The legal basis on which the processing is based for common data, according to Art.6 of the GDPR Regulations, is:

- Consent;

## CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS

3. Without prejudice to communications made in fulfilment of legal and contractual obligations, all data collected and processed may be communicated exclusively for the purposes specified above to the following categories of recipients:

- Authorized persons;
- Data Controller;

## STORAGE PERIOD

The data retention period is: 6 months

## RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

4. Pursuant to European Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR) and the national legislation in force, the interested party may, in accordance with the procedures and within the limits provided for by the legislation in force, exercise the following rights:

- request confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning him/her (right of access of the data subject - art. 15 of Regulation 679/2016);
- know its origin;
- receive intelligible communication;
- have information about the logic, methods and purposes of processing;
- request the updating, rectification, integration, cancellation, transformation into anonymous form, blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those no

longer necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected (right of rectification and cancellation - Articles 16 and 17 of Regulation 679/2016);

- Right to restriction and/or opposition to the processing of data concerning him/her (art. 18 of Regulation 679/2016);
- right of revocation;
- Right to data portability (art. 20 of Regulation 679/2016);
- in cases of processing based on consent, receive their data provided to the owner, in a structured and readable by a data processor and in a format commonly used by an electronic device;
- the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority (data subject's right of access - Article 15 of Regulation 679/2016).

## About Cookies

### What are cookies

A "cookie" is a text file saved on the user's computer when the user accesses a website with the purpose of providing information each time the user returns to the same site. It is a kind of reminder of the internet page visited. With the cookie, the web server sends information to the user's browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, etc.) stored on the user's computer, and will be re-read and updated every time the user returns to the site. In this way the website can automatically adapt to the user. During navigation, the user may also receive on his terminal cookies from different sites ("third party" cookies), set directly by the managers of these websites and used for the purposes and in the manner defined by them.

Depending on their duration, they are divided into session cookies (i.e. those that are temporary and automatically deleted from the terminal at the end of the browsing session by closing the browser) and persistent cookies (i.e. those that remain stored on the terminal until they expire or are deleted by the user).

Depending on the function and purpose of use, cookies can be divided into technical cookies and profiling cookies.

### Technical cookies

Some cookies are used to perform computer authentication, session tracking and store specific information about users accessing a web page. These so-called technical cookies are often useful to allow you to browse a website and use all of its features. Technical cookies are those whose use does not require the user's consent.

Analytics cookies also belong to this category. These are cookies that collect information about how a user uses a website and help to improve the way it works. For example, analytics cookies show which pages are most frequently visited, allow you to see what the recurring patterns of use of a website are, and help you understand any difficulties you are experiencing in using it.

### Profiling cookies

Other cookies can instead be used to monitor and profile users during navigation, study their movements and habits of web browsing or consumption (what they buy, what they read, etc.), also in order to send targeted and personalized services advertising. In this case, we speak of profiling cookies. The use of said cookies requires the prior acquisition of the free informed

consent of the user pursuant to art. 7 of EU Regulation 2016/679 and the national legislation in force.

### **Third-party cookies**

It may also happen that a web page contains cookies coming from other sites and contained in various elements hosted on the page itself, such as advertising banners, images, videos, maps or specific links to web pages of other domains that reside on servers other than the one on which the requested page is located. In other words, these cookies are set directly by managers of websites or servers other than this website. We speak, in these cases, the so-called third party cookies, which are usually used for profiling purposes. The use of these cookies requires the prior acquisition of the free informed consent of the user.

### **Types of cookies used by our site**

The main functions of the cookies installed by [www.camilliani.org/la-visione-e-la-missione-di-cadis-camillian-disaster-service-international](http://www.camilliani.org/la-visione-e-la-missione-di-cadis-camillian-disaster-service-international) are technical, they are used to constantly improve the Service, for authentication, for statistical purposes, such as counting site visits. The use of cookies is therefore strictly aimed at facilitating the functions of the server during the navigation of the Service.

The site also allows the sending of the following third party cookies. These cookies are not instruments of our ownership, for more information, therefore, you can access the information and consent forms of third parties, by clicking on the links provided.

In order to improve the website and understand which parts or elements are most appreciated by users, third party Google Analytics cookies are used as an anonymous and aggregate analysis tool. These cookies are not tools of our ownership, for more information, therefore, you can consult the information provided by Google.

The pages of the website incorporate within them certain Facebook and Google Plus widgets and share buttons, to allow you to share website content on your social channels, and to interact with our channels. These cookies are not tools that we own, but are created by Facebook and Google respectively when you use the respective widget or share button. To learn more visit the following information pages: Facebook and Google.

Some web pages embed video content from YouTube. Visiting a page containing a video, or clicking to view the video, may invoke cookies from YouTube. We do not own these cookies. To learn more, visit Google's policy page.

The website may use Facebook ADS programs operated by Facebook Inc. and Google Ad Words and Google Remarketing technology operated by Google Inc. The conversion tracking feature of Facebook ADS and AdWords also uses cookies to help us track sales and other conversions.

### **Managing Cookies**

The user can manage his/her preferences regarding cookies through the functionalities present in common browsers that allow to delete/remove cookies (all or some) or to change the settings of the browser itself in order to block the sending of cookies or to limit them to specific sites (compared to others).

Therefore it is possible to deny the use of cookies, following the disabling procedure provided by your browser. The following are the procedures proposed by the main browsers: Microsoft Windows Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, Apple Safari, Google Analytics by downloading a specific plug-in of the browser.

## Social Network Plugin
